TIME FOR REHAB?

French mantel clocks are typically constructed of slate, marble, wood or alabaster. The presentation will focus on the rehabilitation of slate and wood cased clocks. Two of the reconstructions to be discussed will involve modifications to cases to fit movements from other clocks. Another of the rehabilitations to be discussed involves repairing a damaged slate case and refinishing the exterior surface.

TIME TRIVIA

The Times Square New Year's Eve Ball came about as a result of a ban on fireworks. The first ball, in 1907, was an illuminated 700-pound iron and wood ball adorned with one hundred 25-watt light bulbs. Today, the round ball, designed by Waterford Crystal, weighs 11,875 pounds, is 12 feet in diameter and is bedazzled with 2,668 Waterford crystals.
