REPAIR AND OPERATION OF 400 DAY CLOCKS

Our topic for the next meeting which will be on Friday Jan. 2, 2015 will be the repair and operation of 400 day clocks. These are also known as "Anniversary Clocks" because they need to be wound only once per year. Jerry Kleeb will provide a discussion on several variations of these fascinating, low powered timepieces.



Paul Martyn will give a beginners corner on the making of a friction fit second hand, without the benefit of using a lathe.

TIME TRIVIA

In the 1840s a railway standard time for all of England, Scotland, and Wales evolved, replacing several "local time" systems. The Royal Observatory in Greenwich began transmitting time telegraphically in 1852 and by 1855 most of Britain used Greenwich time. Greenwich Mean Time (GMT) subsequently evolved as an important and well-recognized time reference for the world.

Movements. Types of movements included Ansonia, Ingraham, Seth Thomas and Waterbury. The video was detailed and covered letting down the mainspring and noted to be careful because the different movements are similar to each other, but have important differences. It showed disassembly, and said to reassemble the way you are comfortable doing. However, Dave noted he would not place a convex glass case glass side down. We also saw how to take a mainspring off the arbor, and another point made was if you use water-based cleaner do not anneal in it the air.

In our Show and Tell segment, following our theme for the night, Jerry Kleeb showed us an American Striking 8 day clock with alarm which is also a New Haven. For the letter “P”, Annette DiMino showed us a paper model of a Patek Phillippe watch which she has painstakingly cut out and is putting together slowly. Ed Athey showed us a Seth Thomas clock he got from our meeting a few months back—it is dated July 1885, has a “wire movement” and the style is named “Reno”.
