That clock was damaged by water on one-half of the clock, so only certain gears needed to be changed. He is working very hard on that repair.

He explained that after many years of cottage industry workers, the clock makers were industrialized into a factory setting. Different metals were used at different times for parts. He also explained the decorative designs on the hoods of the clocks.

We then had our usual Show and Tell, and the Raffle was also held.
